

## Statement of Results – Number Portability for The Bahamas

Today the Utilities Regulation and Competition Authority (URCA) published the document entitled, Number Portability for The Bahamas - Statement of Results (ECS 20/2011). This document reviews the comments made by stakeholders in response to URCA's Number Portability for The Bahamas — Consultation Document (ECS 8/2011) and provides URCA's responses and proposed way forward on each consultation issue. URCA wishes to thank respondents for their comprehensive and fruitful engagement and hopes that stakeholders will continue to engage with URCA on the process to implement Number Portability in The Bahamas.

URCA proposes to continue the process of engaging key stakeholders in respect of Number Portability through the formation of a joint industry/regulator working group on Number Portability, and to that end, URCA will be inviting all holders of Individual Operating Licences to nominate a representative to the Number Portability Working Group, which will deliberate and make recommendations to URCA on plans and processes for the implementation of Number Portability in The Bahamas.
